Internet Foundation Limited is a foundation established in 2006 specifically to discharge as a recognized charity the internet education role in the community hitherto performed by the Internet Professional Association (“iProA”). - to organize campaigns, fund-raising projects and activities to promote, demonstrate, support and carry out any of the above objects and to pay and discharge payments and expenses incurred for such campaigns, projects and activities
